- Good footwear (sneakers or hiking shoes are the best option)
- Clothes for the weather (3 each pants, shirts, underwear, extra socks)
- Rain Jacket
- Fall Sweater
- Winter jacket
- Cold weather Hat
- Gloves or mittens
- Flashlight with extra batteries
- Water Bottle – and always bring to meals
- Coffee mug (adults) – and always bring to meals
- Toothpaste and toothbrush
- Brush or comb
- Camp Chair and/ or Picnic Blanket
- Spending money for the Trading Post

- Wagon for hauling your gear (optional)

### **Important information:**

- If you have food allergies, specific dietary or other needs, please let us know IN ADVANCE of your arrival to camp so that we accommodate your needs as best we can. In addition to listing it in your registration, please send an email to [greitz1953@aol.com](mailto:greitz1953@aol.com).
- Make sure to bring a camp chair or picnic blanket. You will need it for the campfire on Friday night, lunch on Saturday, and the movie on Saturday
- Bring a blanket to wrap up in during the movie. Evenings tend to get pretty cool at camp in the fall.
- This event will go on Rain or Shine. Be prepared for the weather
- There will not be shower Facilities available. Flush toilets might be open, but it depends on the weather (Freezing Temperatures). Be prepared to use the latrines in each campsite. We recommend you bring a 5 gallon water dispenser for hand washing/Teeth brushing. There will be spigots available for water refills.
- Coffee will be available in the dining hall. Please bring a refillable mug!
